

## Revisions to 2022 Reappraisal Plan

---

The original 2022 Reappraisal Plan stated that Zone 2 and Zone 8 would be reinspected. Instead, Chief Appraiser Dyann White proposes that Zones 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 be reinspected. The appraisers will inspect each property within the proposed zones, including ag use inspections for any ag properties within the assigned zones.

There will be no zones targeted for new ag applications. The onsite ag inspection will take the place of requesting updated ag applications by zone.

The proposed calendar accomplishes reinspection within three years, as required by Texas Property Tax Code 25.18(b).

In addition to the Zones stated above, the District will attempt to reinspect all commercial property in the County for the 2022 appraisal year.

**2024** = Zone 5 and Zone 11. **Parcel Count = 3370**

**2025** = Zone 6 and Zone 12. **Parcel Count = 3531**

### Proposed Plan

**2022** = Zone 1, Zone 2, Zone 3, Zone 5, and Zone 6. **Parcel Count = 7073**

**2023** = Zone A, Zone 4, Zone 8, Zone 9. **Parcel Count = 7437**

**2024** = Zone B, Zone 7, Zone 10, Zone 11, Zone 12. **Parcel Count = 7258**
